About

This program aims to provide basic industry skills and knowledge specific to the bricklaying industry and can contribute to gaining an apprenticeship in the building and construction industries (Certificate III level).

Equipment

Safety glasses, overalls/pants/shorts, safety boots, ear muffs & adequate P-1 or P-2 face mask for dust, 1 metre folding ruler, carpenter's pencil, 8 metre tape, pencils in 2H and HB, ball point pen, calculator, 4GB memory stick.

Structured workplace learning

The Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA) has determined that Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) is a valuable component of all VET qualifications undertaken by VCE (including Vocational Major) and VPC students.

VCAA strongly recommends that students undertake a minimum of 80 hours of SWL over the duration of the VCE VET Certificate II in Building and Construction (Bricklaying).
