This practical course will ensure you are prepared to enter the trades industry by introducing you to a range of foundational plumbing skills and knowledge.

- > Safety gloves with cut rate 3
- > Leather work boots, overalls/ cotton work pants and t-shirts or polo shirts are required. **No denim, tracksuit pants, shorts or singlets,**

Structured workplace learning

The Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA) has determined that Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) is a valuable component of all VET qualifications undertaken by VCE VM (including Vocational Major) and VPC students.

VCAA strongly recommends that students undertake a minimum of 80 hours of SWL over the duration of the VCE VET Certificate II in Plumbing (Pre-Apprenticeship).
