# **INFORMATION FOR DIRECT APPLICANTS IN 2024**

Thank you for considering an application for music at Victoria University!

In order to speed up the process of making offers, we are streamlining the assessment of 2024 applications.

You may not need to attend an audition and interview to be considered for a place in the Bachelor of Music, if you are able to provide us with evidence of your ability and experience.

## If you are planning to apply

Please include in your application:

- 1. A folio of evidence of musical education and experience (instrument(s)/voice, CV, school subjects, certificates, work experience, etc)
- Links to video or audio performing music of your choice, including any live concerts or gigs you may have recorded.

You can provide this information and attach relevant documents to your <u>direct application</u>. The Admissions team will forward it to the music staff for assessment.

If we are satisfied with the information you provide us, we may be able to make you an offer straight away without the need to audition and interview.

## If you have already applied

Did you already provide a folio or supporting documentation with your application?

**YES** - No further action required, we will assess what you provided. If we need further information or to arrange an interview we will contact you via email.

**NO** - email us your folio, and include your full name, VU application reference number, and VU student ID (if known), and the course code ABMC. Subject: *Bachelor of Music application – additional information*

## If you need to audition or interview

If we need more information from you, we may book an audition and/or interview with you. We will contact you via email as soon as possible.

#### PREPARING YOUR VIDEOS

- mp4 video files or YouTube links are preferred. A basic phone video is acceptable.
- mp3 audio files are accepted if video is not possible.
- Upload your files to a cloud server like Google Drive or Microsoft OneDrive and create a sharable link with no password.
- DO NOT attach large files as attachments to the email
- Email the links to your files or YouTube to <a href="mailto:admissions@vu.edu.au">admissions@vu.edu.au</a> and <a href="mailto:Robert.Bell@vu.edu.au">Robert.Bell@vu.edu.au</a> with your application reference and VU ID.

We will assess you on a range of criteria, including: technical ability, musicality, dynamics, tonal quality, intonation, rhythmic accuracy and tempo, understanding of musical form and interaction with accompanying musicians and/or music.

## PREPARING YOUR FOLIOS

A folio helps us make an informed decision about your experiences, interests, and ability to succeed in the course. Failure to provide a folio may incur delays in notifying you of an outcome.

Folio items may include:

- · transcripts of results of general and music-related studies
- CV of work experience, musical and non-musical
- relevant written references
- any other material that demonstrates interest in or capacity for the course, e.g. copies of gig flyers, photos of you performing, etc.
- links to online videos/sites of performances and other relevant material

Please ensure documents can be opened easily – doc, docx, pdf and jpeg are preferred.
