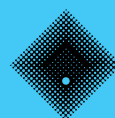



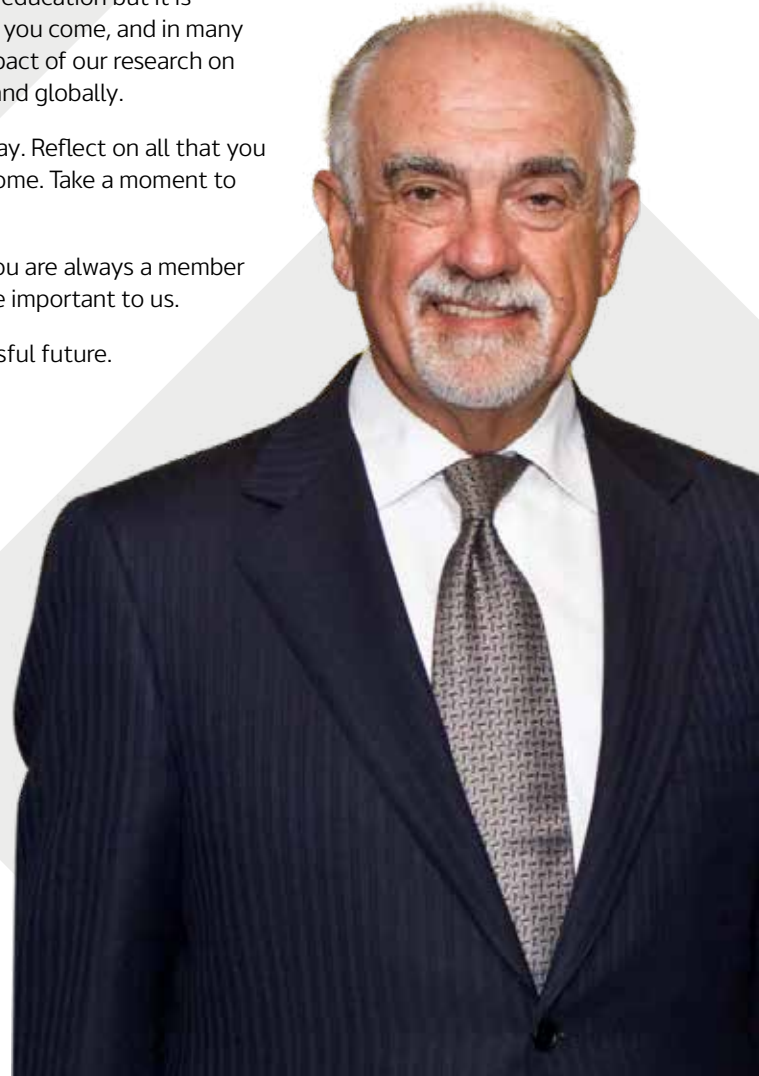
Please stay connected through our extensive Alumni network. You are always a member of our community and, as with all our students you will always be important to us.



ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF COUNTRY

Victoria University acknowledge the Ancestors, Elders and families of the Boonwurrung and Woiwurrung of the Kulin who are the traditional owners of University land. As we share our own knowledge practices within the University may we pay respect to the deep knowledge embedded within the Aboriginal community and their ownership of Country. We acknowledge that the land on which we meet is a place of age old ceremonies of celebration, initiation and renewal and that the Kulin people's living culture has a unique role in the life of this region.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE – AN ESTABLISHED TRADITION

Our graduation ceremonies begin with the entrance of the University mace, signifying the authority of the Chancellor. Carried by the Mace Bearer, the mace symbolises learning, scholarship and our rich history. The mace connects us with those who have come before and those who will follow in the pursuit of learning. Made of sterling silver and 24-carat gold, the design includes the letter 'V', standing for Victoria – our University's home and namesake.

ACADEMIC DRESS

Wearing academic dress on ceremonial occasions is a celebrated university tradition, and generally consists of a gown (also known as a robe) with a separate hood (also known as a stole), and usually a cap – doctoral candidates wear a bonnet. Throughout the Commonwealth, universities usually follow the academic dress style of Oxford or Cambridge. Our academic dress is based on the Oxford style. Traditionally, the Chancellor’s gown is faced in gold and the Vice-Chancellor’s gown is faced in silver.

The colour of the hood (stole) identifies the discipline:

The gowns worn by graduating students help distinguish undergraduate and higher degrees:

- ◆ undergraduates and postgraduates wear a black gown – Vocational Education, Further Education and undergraduate gowns have a large slit in each sleeve
- ◆ the masters gown has a long narrow sleeve extension
- ◆ doctoral candidates wear a red gown.

Masters – a black gown and black cap with a black hood fully lined with the discipline colour.

Doctors – a black bonnet with a gold cord, a scarlet gown with a facing and a black hood fully lined with the discipline colour.

Indigenous Australians – the gown of their award together with a calf-length black and red silk stole with gold tassels, a map of Victoria in gold silk, ‘Victoria University’ embroidered in gold on the left end of the stole, the sun embroidered in gold silk and ‘Ngaga Jindi Woraback’ embroidered in gold on the right end of the stole.

In official abbreviations of our awards, Victoria University is abbreviated to VicMelb.

ACADEMIC DRESS FOR PARTICULAR AWARDS IS AS FOLLOWS:

Certificates – a black cap and an undergraduate gown with a black stole with a facing of tangerine.

Diplomates and Graduate Certificates – a black cap and an undergraduate gown with a black stole with a facing in the discipline colour.

Bachelors – a black gown and black cap with a black hood half lined with the discipline colour. The hood for the honours degree has a white band on the edge of the hood.

Interviews revealed that students' experiences enhance and limit their awareness of possibilities. The research showed an absence of support for the broadening of students' career understanding. Her research exposed the rhetoric and reality of mandatory CPD illuminating a disconnect between the Australian nursing regulatory body and the nurses it registers. Her thesis was applauded by examiners who described it as foundational work for future researchers.

Citation: Manpreet expanded the understanding of the interactions among milk components, particularly milk proteins, that affect storage stability of long life, or UHT, milk. She also developed a rapid tool for predicting the shelf life of UHT milk, which was much sought after by the dairy industry. Manpreet received international recognition after being published highly ranked journals which led to several research collaborations with outstanding research institutions including NIZO Food Research and University College Cork in Ireland.

The law was also examined within the context of Derrida's deconstructions of rationality, the metaphysics of presence, and what Derrida described and as the Western culture of sacrifice. It provides arguments for better protections for nonhuman animals.

immunogenicity and potential allergenicity thus providing guideline for manufacturing of hypoallergenic and safe milk.

She posited that optimisation of this legal framework for the New World regimes of Victoria Australia and Virginia USA compared to the Old World regimes of Europe. Her research highlighted the limitations and challenges in the use of social enterprise for this purpose. His findings, from analysis of the Australian Taekwondo team, revealed that the affective and cognitive demands of practice do not adequately represent the competitive setting are already influencing national sporting organisations concerned with enhancing skill practice. Hendro analysed messages on an Indonesian social network using a association rules and cluster analysis. The results of a series of experiments revealed that insulting words were associated with disabilities, psychological disorders and animals. Relationships between human rights violations data and cyber-bullying messages were also discovered.

The interviews with AEOs and their service providers revealed that the agency cost of control and coordination of partners through contractual arrangement offered the widest security extension in the export chain.

Thesis title: Inclusion, Emotion and Voice: Permanent Public Art Made by Community Members

Citation: This thesis used words and drawings to produce powerful portraits of two community art projects: the Blacksmiths' Tree produced after the 2008 bush fires in Victoria and the Great Wall ceramic mural in St Kilda. The examiners noted that the work was shaped by sense and sensibility with one commenting "The form of the thesis is inspiring, aesthetically eloquent, visually evocative and intellectually moving".

Nana is an Australia Awards Scholarship awardee and works at the Ministry of Finance, Indonesia. Ainsley's study makes an outstanding contribution to understanding efficacy of stem cell therapy to attenuate intestinal inflammation and damage to the nerves in the gut. Ainsley published 13 papers in high impact journals during her PhD studies. She is currently a Post Doctoral Research Officer at La Trobe University.

Thesis title: The Jekyll and Hyde Element: The Career of Geelong Football Club Champion and Media Celebrity John 'Sam' Newman

Citation: Few Australian Rules football players have had their lives subjected to academic scrutiny. Julian's thesis deployed triangulation to examine the football and media careers of John 'Sam' Newman, a former champion with the Geelong Football Club. He concluded that Newman is a complex person, exhibiting two contrasting personalities (narcissistic and opinionated as opposed to warm and generous) that sometimes come together.

Thesis title: Income Inequality, Corruption and Market Power: an Econometric Analysis

Citation: Income inequality has been rising across many OECD countries. This study examines whether market power and corruption are key drivers of this trend across nations and states in the USA. The evidence points to strong linkages particularly between income inequality and corruption. These insights are valuable for public policy on market distortions and social welfare.

Thesis title: The Effects of Porous Surfaces on the Control of Flows Over Bluff Bodies of Circular, Square and Rectangular Cross-Sections

Citation: Bluff bodies are objects that are not streamlined, such as trucks. In the case of vehicles this increases their fuel consumption. The resistance that increases energy consumption can be reduced by coating them with porous media. Parvaneh has carried out a detailed experimental and theoretical study of the mechanisms of drag reduction, and her results set the benchmark for future studies

Thesis title: The Role of Self-Efficacy Factors, Individual Characteristics and Wil Participation on Accounting Near-Graduate Students' Employment Outcomes

Citation: This is the first study in accounting education to analyse the role of the three factor self-efficacy construct on accounting near-graduates' employment. The study found that two factors: persistence and initiative, along with work-integrated learning, significantly influenced employment outcomes. This study made important recommendations for key stakeholders to incorporate self-efficacy and Work Integrated Learning in university curricula.

Citation: Renee's research examined the use of enzyme inhibitors on reduced blood flow in heart disease. Further knowledge in this area will improve outcomes in patients with increased risk of stroke and heart attack.

Rehenuma conducted a pilot RCT of an innovative peer-delivered programme with 70 pregnant women in Bangladesh. Outcomes showed that, at post-intervention, the intervention group had a significant decrease in depressive symptoms and a slight increase in self-esteem and quality of life compared with the control group.
